John Stark Edwards House Museum

The Trumbull County Historical Society was formed in 1843. The Edwards-Webb-Iddings house was built in 1807, and was purchased by the Society and dedicated as a museum in 1938. It is supported in part by membership fees and donations and is governed by a board of trustees elected by the members. The Society holds four social educational events annually for members and their guests.

A short program on various subjects is offered 30 minutes prior to the house opening for tours on Sunday open house days. Trained docents are available for private tours upon request.

The Society helps individuals with questions on preservation. It is dedicated to identifying and cataloguing historical structures existing in each of the 25 townships. The volunteer staff also offers research services for a donation.
